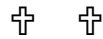

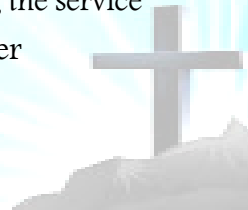

For CHILDREN in our congregation:

A **Nursery** for infant to pre-school age children is available every Sunday service. The Nursery is located in the basement of the church with workers on staff from 10:15am until service finishes. Also, a

Sunday School Program is offered for all kindergarten to elementary school age children in the Christian Education Center next door. Children normally remain in the service until the *Children's Time* and then are escorted by the Sunday School teacher & Youth Helper to the other building (top floor). Lastly, children are always welcome to stay with family during the service if they so wish. Activity sheets & crayons are provided on the Welcome Center for any child wanting a small activity during the 1 hour service.



***Allergy Alert:** Going forward the Nursery will be equipped with nut free/dairy free/soy free/gluten free snacks. In order to avoid the risk of allergies, we would like to ask parents to please utilize snacks provided rather than bringing in a treat for your child that may jeopardize the health of others. 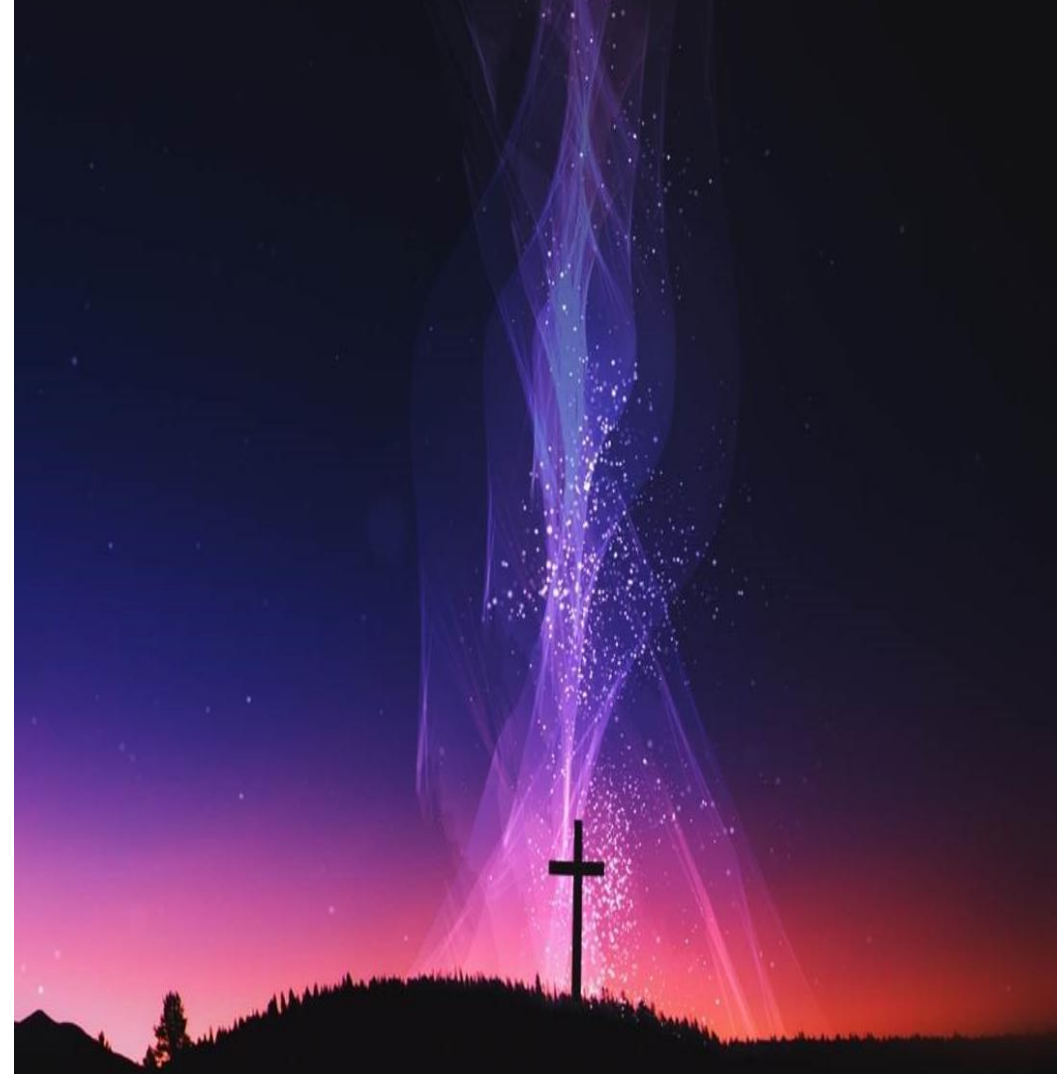
