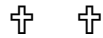


LANCASTER BAPTIST CHURCH

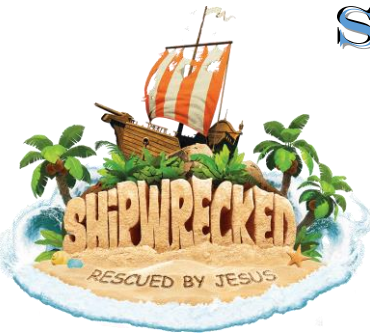
