Sunday, November 11, 2018 marks the centenary of the armistice that led to the end of the Great War, also known as The First World War. More than 16 million people lost their lives in that conflict. It is calculated that the average life expectancy for a soldier during that war was 42 days. Close to 61,000 Canadians died in the Great War, others returned broken in body and mind. It is reported that more than 24,000 New Brunswick men and women served in uniform from 1914 to 1918.



Across Canada people gather on November 11th to remember those who paid the supreme price, and to honour the Veterans who have served our nation. On this one hundredth anniversary of the 1918 armistice we remember particularly those from our area who served our country in the First World War, some of whose names appear on the memorial window in our sanctuary.

The prophet Isaiah looked forward to a time when, "They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore."
